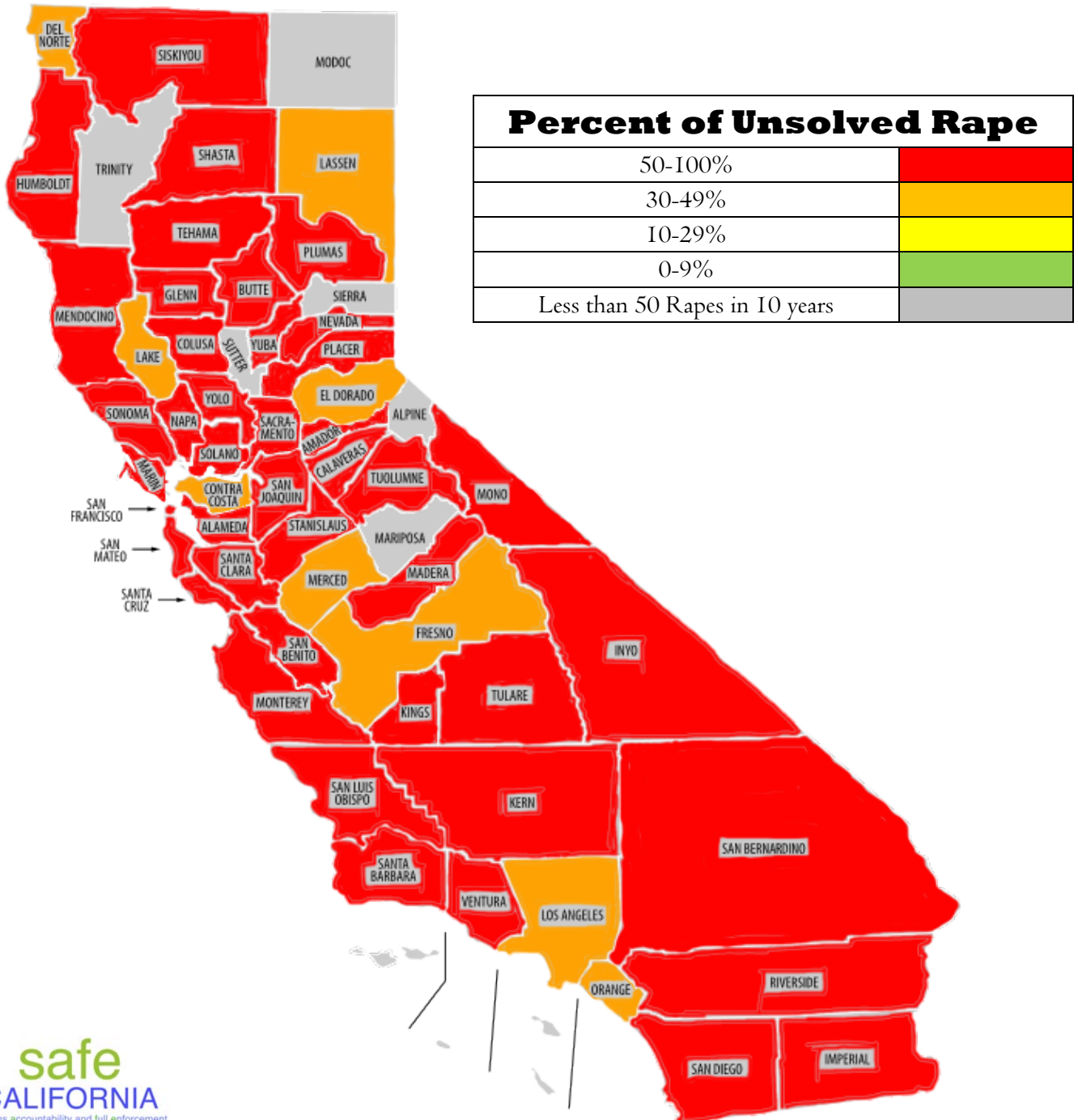


# Unsolved Rape in California

This map shows the percent of unsolved rapes in each California County for the last 10 years. The percent was calculated by adding the total number of rapes from 2000-2009 and subtracting it from the total number of rape clearances in the same time frame. The counties highlighted on this map represent 99.5% of all rapes committed in the state, and 99.4% of all unsolved rapes. Unsolved rapes were not calculated for the counties shaded in grey because those counties experienced 50 or fewer rapes in the last 10 years.
